All our children have grown up playing in the field, exercising our dogs, flying their kites and picking wild fruit

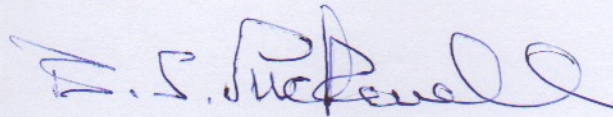
Such as blackberries and crab apples, also during the winter when it snowed our children and grandchildren would enjoy

Sledging as would many other family's from the local area.

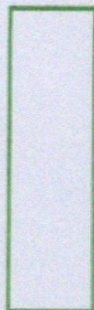
Our grandchildren are now getting the same pleasure as their parents did by playing in Humpty Hill field.
