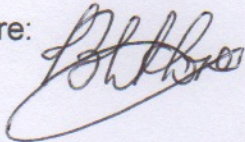


Application to register as a Town Green,

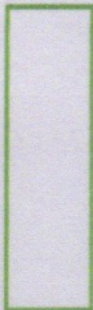
