Witness Statement in support of the Application

1. I, Catherine Robinson, of 2 Eaton Close, Faringdon, state that I have lived in Faringdon since October 1997. From 1997 till 2004 I lived at 47 London Street, then in 2004 moved to Eaton Close.
2. My family and I first made use of the field in 2004 for sledging and have done so ever since if there has been enough snow.

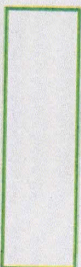
