Witness Statement in support of the Application

1. I, Edward Williams, of 14 Beech Close, Faringdon, state my wife and I moved to Faringdon in July 1973 with our two young children. We lived at 21 Chestnut Avenue from 1973 till 1975, then at 5 Maple Road, until moving to Beech Close in 1980.
2. We first made use of the field in 1974 for dog walking and this has continued on a regular basis, apart from occasional gaps between dogs. In addition to walking around the perimeter pathway, I often walk into the centre of the field. This means I still get sufficient exercise without having to climb the hill and can easily see the dog in most parts of the field. It also reduces the likelihood of the dog straying unto adjacent fields.
3. I have also used the field for blackberry picking, kite flying, flying model aircraft and sledging in the snow. When my son was in Faringdon Cubs they often used the field for various activities.
4. I have observed other people using the field for golf practice, dog training and bird watching.
