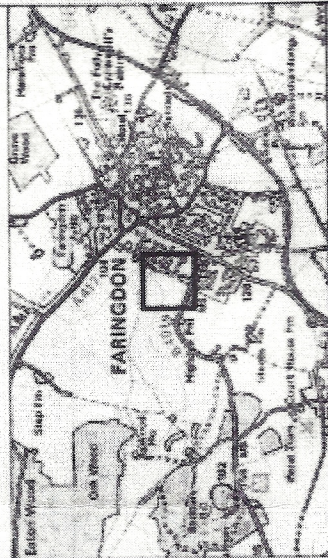

Approximate route of unaffected rights of way



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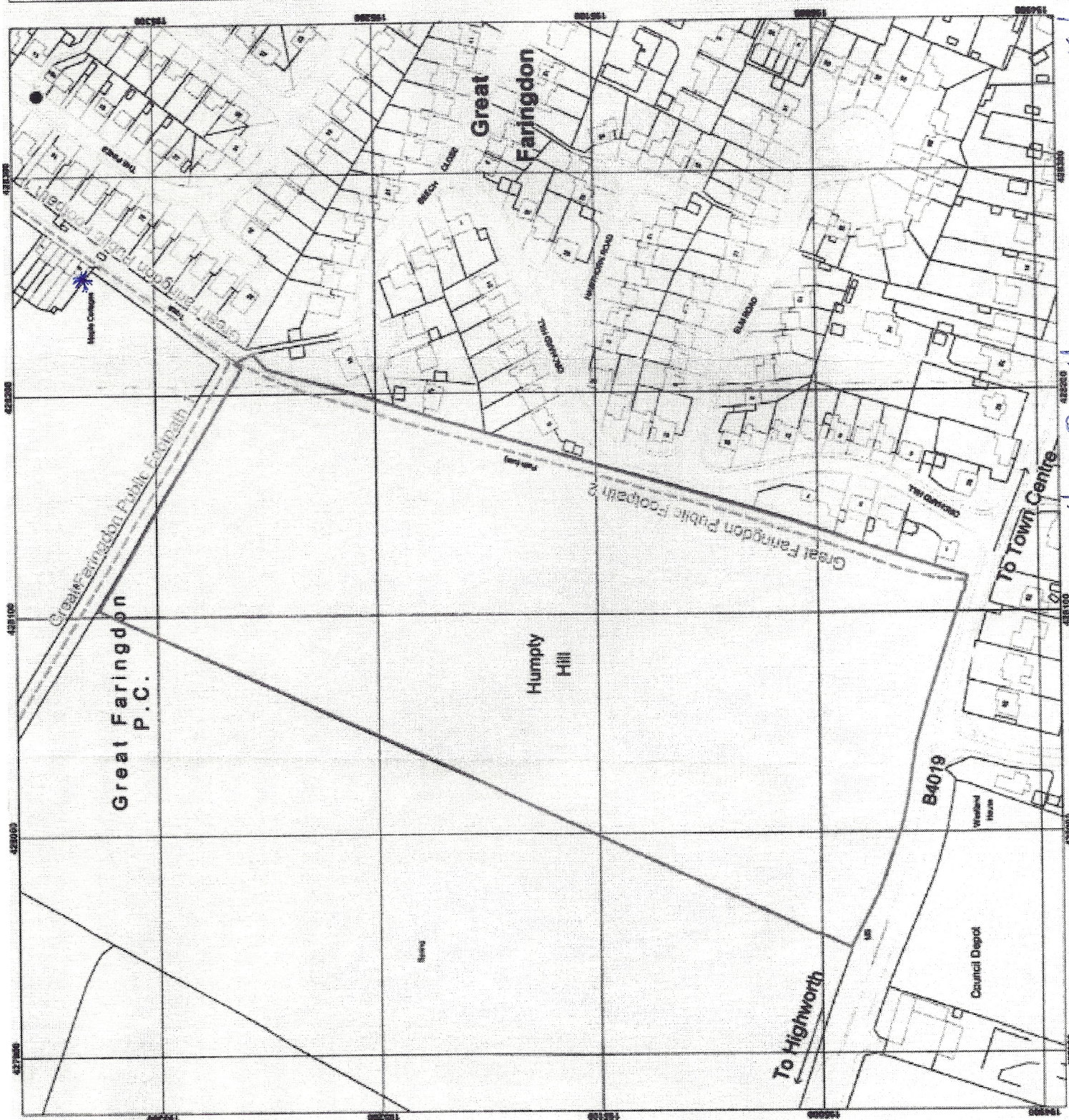

We have lived 50 yards from the field in question for over 40 years. Our proximity to the field has made it a close part of our lives for a considerable time.
