

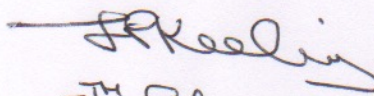

- 2. We have always enjoyed the use of Humpty Hill for various activities. I try to regularly walk round using the path but also do cross the field, this is usually in summer when it is drier but we do exercise here throughout the year.**
- 3. As a family with children and now grandchildren we toboggan down this hill whenever we have snow. My husband often take the grand children to fly a kite and we all have enjoyed picking the blackberries in the autumn.**
- 4. There are regular dog walkers at all times of day, starting as early as 6am through till the evening, it is the only area this side of town to be able to do this.**
- 5. We live opposite Humpty Hill, it is very unusual not to see someone in the field using it in various ways, just throwing a ball, playing frisbee, dog walking, flying model aircraft, tobogganing or walking.**
