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## Witness Statement in support of the Application

I, June Shields, have resided at 20 The Pines, Faringdon from 1988 to the present day.

My family has made full use of Humpty Hill since we settled in Faringdon in 1988. We use the area for exercise including walking the full area of the field and running around the perimeter pathway.

We have also used the field for recreational activities such as sledging, ball games and kite flying, at all times we have seen other families using the field for family activities.

Local children regularly use this field for playing especially in the summer holidays. My own children spent many hours playing with their friends in the field, there are no alternative areas of a reasonable size in this part of the town for children to run around and play.

My family made use of the field for dog walking twice daily from 1988 until 2003, this involved use of the full area. Many local people use the field for exercising their dogs on a regular daily basis.

We have never been challenged on entering or during our use of the field and asked to leave.

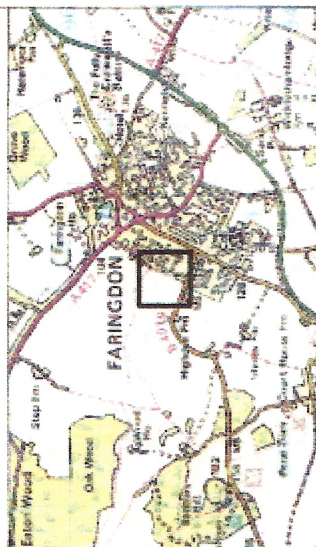
## NLREG34: Great Faringdon Humpty Hill
