I have lived in Faringdon since February 2010 and would be devastated to see Humpty Dumpty hill built upon. It is an area of outstanding beauty and green space which is heavily utilised by residents. Building on the site would significantly alter the view from our house.

I have observed birds of prey on the hill and rabbits. It would be such a shame to destroy the natural habitat of these animals.

Dog walkers use the land all the time. We do not own a dog but I appreciate the need for green space to allow dogs to be exercised.

We have used Humpty Dumpty hill for sledging in the winter and had so much fun. On windy days we fly kites with the children and in the Autumn we have picked blackberries.

We go for walks on the hill and use it to walk into town which gives a far more scenic route and prevents us from having to use main roads and with young children, it is safer to avoid using busy main roads.

We have never been questioned by landowners or farmers. Moreover, everyone we encounter on the hill appears to have gained the courtesy and manners of the countryside and many "good mornings" are muttered!

Building on the hill would increase the traffic on the Highworth road. My family and I would find it harder to get in and out of our road. The noise would be increased and the coxwell and Highworth roads would get significantly busier..... They are already so much busier than they used to be!

Please listen to the residents of Faringdon who feel so strongly about the proposals. People of Faringdon feel it has significantly changed over the years and feel the infrastructure of the town cannot cope with many more houses. Schools and the Drs are bursting at the seams.
