Witness Statement in support of the Application

I, Michelle Stewart, of 26 Park Road, Faringdon, state that I have lived in Faringdon Since 1990. From 1990 until 1991 I lived at 9 Beech Close, then at 5 Kiln Terrace from 1991, 41 Bromsgrove from 1994, 4 Cadels Row from 2003, 15 The Pines from 2006 until I moved to Park Road in 2009.

I first made use of the field in the early 1990's when I used to meet friends in the field to lie on the grass, relaxing, sitting at the top of the hill enjoying the view and would meet most evenings to walk friends dogs. We would sit in Humpty Hill to watch the Airshow at RAF Fairford and Faringdon Fireworks. As an adult I frequently use the field to exercise my dog, take photographs of the views pick berries and even just to enjoy the peace and quiet. I have often been in the field when they have been cutting and bailing and have never been asked to leave or stop visiting the area.

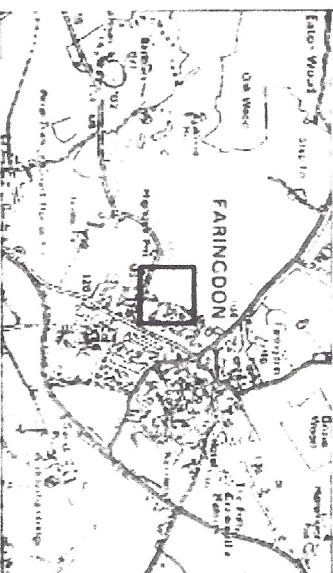
