We would sledge whenever the snow came.

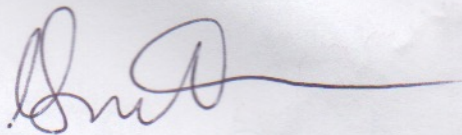
As I got older it was a safe place to secretly drink cider without our parents knowing - but we knew we were safe.
