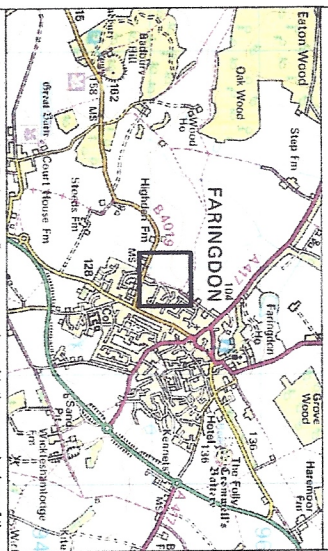

WITNESS STATEMENT prepared by:

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My family and I have, over the years, made use of Humpty Hill as a recreational space. We either enter the site at the lower end from Canada Lane or from the top entrance off Highworth Road.

In winter months, when there has been snow on the ground, we have used the site for activities such as tobogganing.

In the summer months we have used the perimeter footpath, which offers a pleasant alternative to walking along roads on our way back from the centre of Faringdon to home. We have also, on occasion, picked blackberries from along the field perimeter. On these occasions we have seen others, generally adults, making use of the site for exercising dogs and children or teenagers using the space for general play.

The field is particularly useful for recreational activities mentioned above since I have never seen any livestock in the field, and the ground is thus free of livestock droppings etc.. I have never been approached by the landowner when I have been in the field.
