Witness Statement in support of the Application

1. I, Robert Kelly, of 27 Beech Close, Faringdon, state that I have lived in Faringdon since 1962, having been born and raised just two miles outside of the town, so I have known Faringdon and the surrounding area all my life, including working in the town.
2. My wife was born about one hundred yards from Humpty Hill and used to walk through the field on her way to and from the then Junior School in Canada Lane. Often stopping to play on the way. She says she was never challenged by the farmer and does not remember ever seeing cows in the field.
3. In recent times, we have used the field ;-
 - a. To walk a neighbour's dog.
 - b. As a play area for children when they visit us.
 - c. Blackberry picking
4. I often see people in the field ;-
 - a. Walking and training dogs.
 - b. Sometimes flying kites.
 - c. Picking blackberries and crab apples.
5. After heavy snowfalls the field is a magnet for children and families to enjoy tobogganing, snowball fights and building snowmen. In January 2010, a huge snowball was made and left in the middle of the field. It took many weeks for it to disappear.
