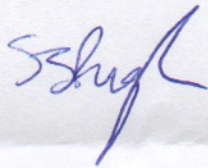


**Application to register as a town green,

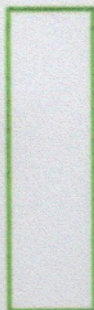
