Humpty Hill is the only field on that side of Faringdon to do these activities.

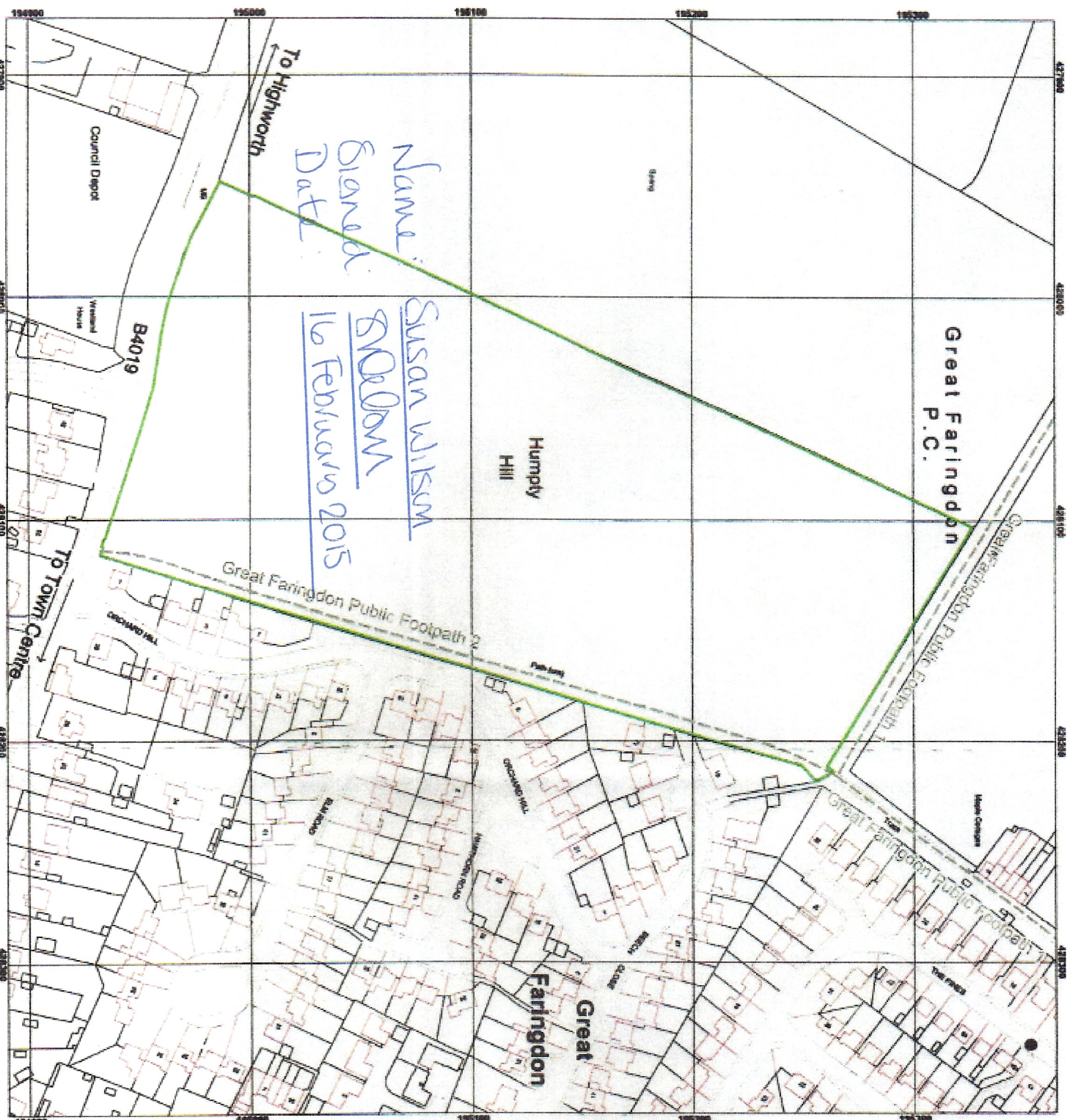
I have never seen any livestock in the field and I have never been approached by anyone claiming to be the landowner.

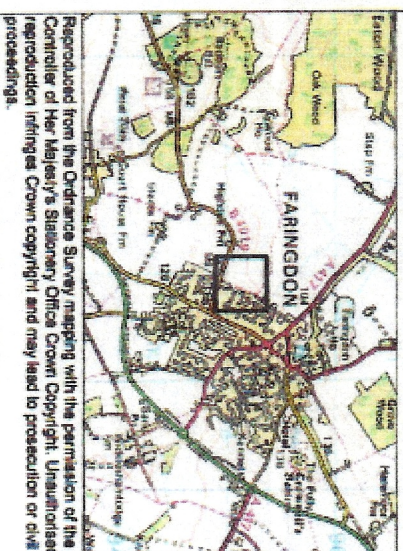
