Witness Statement in support of the Application

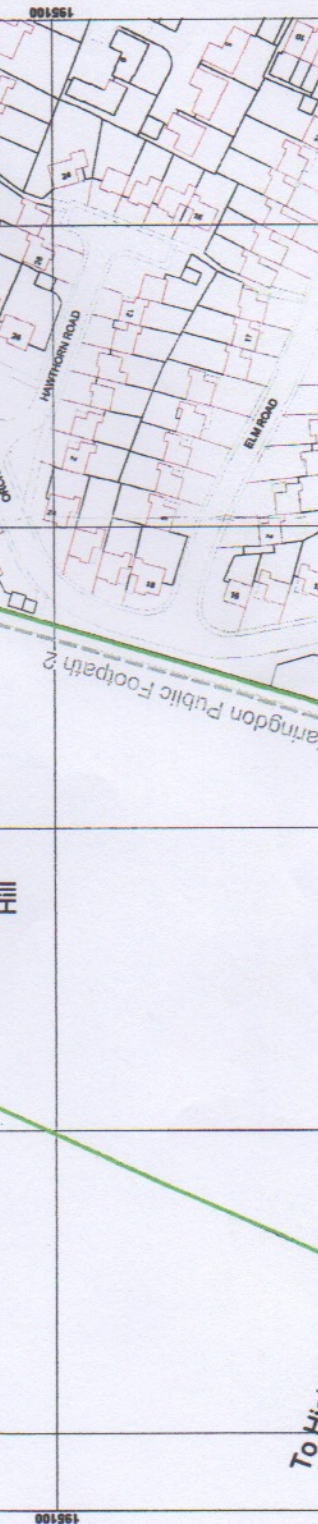
1. I, Suzanne Hayhurst-France, of 7 Eastfield Court, Faringdon, state that I have lived in Faringdon Since July 1969. From 1969 – 1984 I lived at 2 Fernham Road, Faringdon, from 1984 – 2004 at 9 Orchard Hill, Faringdon, and from 2004 – 2014 at 7 Orchard Hill, Faringdon.
2. Both properties lived in at 9 Orchard Hill and 7 Orchard Hill had views overlooking Humpty Hill field. I have observed people taking dogs for a walk, families on their way to the children's school, and people picking blackberries. The field has been used as a play area by many children and families, including bicycle rides, football, cricket, rounders, frisbee and kite flying. I have witnessed dogs receiving training. I have witnessed scouts in uniform utilising the field for their activities. Due to the nature of the hill, the area is a prime tobogganing area for Faringdon residence when snow has fallen.
3. I have utilised the field myself, supervising my grandchildren when they were younger. They thoroughly enjoyed playing in the open space provided, and as they grew up, so they would look forward to utilising the field space for their games independently.
